Beginning chant

(Offer rice grains on the upper pictures)

Swamiji: **Dhyānam**

(Meditation on Dattātreya and Anaghadevī, the Śakti of Dattātreya, the divine female primordial energy)

Their wealth-giving eyes are like semi-bloomed flowers,

The brightness from their smiles is like moonlight reflecting in rivers,

The grand yoga light emanates from the middle of their eyebrows (ajna chakra area).

Their hands are adorned with mala, lotus, varada (boon giving) and abhaya (do not fear) mudras,

Their beautiful feet are visible because of the padmasana posture they are in.

I meditate upon such anagha couple who are imprinted in my mind without fading.

Their thoughts are fully in my mind.

(Offer rice grains in the middle)

Swamiji: Parivāra Devata Dhyānam (Meditation on the 8 supernatural powers)

(Offer rice grains on nr. 1-8 during the chanting)

- 1. Anima become as small as an atom
- 2. Laghima become as light as light
- 3. Prāpti be omnipresent
- Prākāmya fulfill ones all desires
- 5. **īshitva** absolute power to create and destroy
- **6. Vashitva** supreme mastery over material matter
- 7. Kāmāvasāyita assume any form
- 8. Mahima infinitely expand

Swamiji:

1. **Āvāhanam** (invocation)

(Offer rice grains in the middle)

- 2. **Āsanam** (offer a seat)
- 3. **Pādyam** (offer water to wash feet)
- 4. **Arghyam** (offer water to wash hands)
- 5. **Ācamanam** (offer water to sip)
- 6. **Madhuparkam** (offer sweet drink of honey)
- 7. **Pancamṛta snānam** (bath with 5 nectars: milk, yoghurt, ghee, honey, sugar)
- 8. **Snānam** (offer bath with pure water)
- 9. **Vastram** (offer clothing)
- 10. **Upavītam** (offer sacred thread)
- 11. **Gandham** (offer sandal paste)
- 12. **Kuṃkumam** (offer kumkum)
- 13. **Ābharanam** (offer jewellry)
- 14. **Puṣpam** (offer flowers)
- 15. **Dhūpam** (offer incense stick)
- 16. **Dīpam** (offer light with oil lamp)
- 17. **Naivedyam** (offer food, fruits)
- 18. **Tāmbulam** (offer betel leaves)
- 19. Ārati (offer camphor-light)
- 20. **Mantra puspam** (flowers for personal prayer)

- 21. **Pradakṣinam** (circumabulating the altar, here: turnaround oneself 3x to the right, then bow)
- 22. **Punaḥ pūja** (offer the entire pūja with this one offering again)
- 23. **Kṣama prārthanam** (prayer for forgiveness for mistakes done during the pūja)
- 24. **Arpanam** (offer the fruit of all actions done by the body, mind, speech, sense organs, intellect, intuition and inherent nature)
- 25. **Prārthanam** (prayer)
- 26. **Phala samarpaṇam** (offer the merit of the pūja)
