ekadantāya vakratuṇḍāya
śrī gaṇeśāya namaḥ

Reverence to him with one tooth, with the
curved trunk, to the God of wisdom (*gaṇeśa*)

modahastāya raktavarṇāya
lambodarāya namaḥ

Reverence to him holding round sweets in the
hand, having a large belly, who is of red
complexion

hastivadanāya sūkṣmanetrāya
sarpasūtrāya namaḥ

Reverence to him with the elephant face, with
the tiny eyes, wearing the snake as girdle

buddhipradāya siddhināthāya
pāśahastāya namaḥ

Reverence to him the bestower of intelligence
who mastered the *siddhis*, holding the noose in
the hand

arkarūpāya nāṭyapriyāya
gaurisutāya namaḥ

Reverence to him whose form appears in the
arka root, who is fond of the dance, to the son of
Gauri

durgāpriyāya duritadūrāya
dukhaharaṇāya namaḥ

Reverence to him, who is dear to Durgā, to the
remover of difficulties, who destroys suffering

prathamavandyāya pāpanāśāya
paramātmāne namaḥ

Reverence to him, who is worshipped at the
beginning, who annihilates sins, to the highest
ātman

sakalavidyāya sādhuvidyāya
saccidānandāya namaḥ

Reverence to him of complete wisdom who is
revered by the saints, to *sacchidānanda*
